## Volunteers agree to:

Support Caring in Bristol to fulfill its aims by carrying out your role to the best of your ability

Listen to and respect CiB staff and team leaders

Follow all CiB training, policies and procedures and complete a DBS check if your role requires it

Maintain the confidentiality of service users - but do not keep secrets

Report any safeguarding concerns to us as soon as possible

Adhere to and respect all individuals' boundaries while volunteering and follow our Code of Conduct

Be realistic with your volunteering time commitment and let us know as soon as possible if you cannot make a volunteering shift

Do not volunteer under the influence of alcohol or drugs

Let us know if you have any physical or mental health conditions so we can make reasonable adjustments and support you

## CiB agrees to:

Provide appropriate induction and training to all volunteers

Support you during your volunteering with us through effective communication and feedback opportunities

Keep you safe with our Health & Safety and Safeguarding guidance

Promote diversity, inclusion and equal opportunities

Listen to any safeguarding or safety concerns that you have and respond appropriately to them as soon as possible

Hold appropriate insurance cover for all volunteering roles

Reward and recognise the amazing contribution that all our volunteers make to Caring in Bristol

Ensure all staff follow CiB policies and procedures

Reimburse volunteer expenses related to your role in a timely manner

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
